

# How To...

## Day 17: We're going on a plant hunt!

Take a plant safari in your garden or the local area. Armed with a camera, take photos of the plants you find and try to identify what they are. Create a labelled gallery of your photos and open the doors of the gallery for your family to look round.



### Instructions

1. Get an iPad, tablet or camera of some sort.
2. Take a walk around your garden or do this in your local area while you are out getting your daily exercise.
3. Take photos of all the plants that you find.
4. Take a close up photograph of the plant as well as a picture of the plant in the area it was found.
5. Try to identify the plants as you go around.
6. Use a plant ID guide (or a plant ID app such as 'Picture This') to help with the identification.
7. When completed, display the photos of the plants with labels that identify what they are – this could be a digital or printed display.
8. You could even draw or paint the plants in your photos and create a gallery of your plants.
