### Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) – Years 1 to 6

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may be aware, the teaching of RSE was made compulsory for all primary schools in September 2020. At Greenside, this has been part of our wider Personal, Social, Health and Economic education (PSHE) curriculum prior to it becoming statutory because we know how crucial it is to pupils' well-being and development.

Next half term, teachers from Years 1 to 6 will be delivering RSE in their PSHE lessons. From past experience, we know that some parents and carers may feel apprehensive about the lesson content. Therefore, we invite you to a parent workshop on **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November at 9am** in the school hall where we will provide an overview of the lesson coverage and answer any questions you may have.

The majority of the RSE curriculum centres on building and maintaining safe and healthy relationships and helping children to understand the physical changes their bodies undergo as they grow. All content has been considered carefully and the curriculum is mapped so that it is age-appropriate. RSE lessons are taught by class teachers using an approved scheme of learning titled, 'Yasmine and Tom'. The programme uses two characters as a tool for highlighting important changes to the body and keeping safe.

Naturally, your child may come home and discuss what they have learned with you. If you wish to know the day RSE lessons will be taught in your child's class, please contact their teacher directly. Please note, if your child is in a mixed class, e.g. Dazzling Dolphins or Adventurous Anacondas, the children will be taught the content for their year group only.
