The Enormous Crocodile the Musical & National Science and Media Museum

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to inform you that on **Thursday 16th July**, Reception will be going on a day trip to **Alhambra Theatre and National Science and Media Museum, Bradford** as part of their Literacy and Science learning. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to watch a musical performance of Roald Dahl's 'The Enormous Crocodile', followed a visit to The National Science and Media Museum, where we will have our lunch and explore the different areas, including the Wonderlab exhibition.

The trip will take place during normal school hours. We will leave school after morning registration and return in time for the end of the school day at 3:10pm.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of £26.95 per child to fund the cost of the coach transport and theatre ticket costs. The trip is available to view in Arbor and you must register your child's place and make payment by **Monday 29th June**. No child will be denied the opportunity to take part in the visit in the event of parents/carers being unable to pay the contribution, however, please note that if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will have to be cancelled and all monies returned. In cases of hardship you are invited to speak in confidence to Mrs Fuller.

On the day, children will need a healthy snack, a packed lunch and a drink. A packed lunch can be provided by school as part of universal free school meals for Reception pupils. Please complete the following form if you wish to order a school packed lunch for your child.
