Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to inform you that on **Wednesday 20th May 2026** all Year 5 and Year 6 classes will be going on a day trip to Bolton Abbey as part of our geography learning. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to participate in a workshop focusing on the erosion and deposition of the River Wharfe; history of the priory at Bolton Abbey; and the impacts of tourism on the Bolton Abbey estate as well as completing some fieldwork in the grounds of Bolton Abbey.

We aim for the trip to be the full duration of the school day and therefore will be leaving school before 9am. Please ensure all children arrive at school promptly on this day. We should return for the usual finish at 3.15pm.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£14.40** per child to fund the cost of the coach transport. The trip is available to view in Arbor and you must register your child's place and make payment by **Friday 1st May**. No child will be denied the opportunity to take part in the visit in the event of parents/carers being unable to pay the contribution, however, please note that if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will have to be cancelled and all monies returned. In cases of hardship, you are invited to speak in confidence to Mrs Fuller.

Children will need a healthy snack, a packed lunch and a drink. A packed lunch can be provided by school, if your child is eligible for free school meals. Please complete the following form if you wish to order a school packed lunch for your child.

For most of the day, pupils will be outdoors participating in the workshop and carrying out their fieldwork; therefore, pupils must dress appropriately for outdoor conditions. Children are permitted to wear appropriate joggers, leggings or walking trousers (such as those worn as part of their PE uniform) but this must be accompanied by their Greenside school jumper or cardigan. Children are advised to wear either walking boots or sturdy trainers. Weather dependent, children should wear a suitable waterproof coat and can bring a small backpack with an additional layer, warm hat, sun hat and sun cream as advised closer to the time.
