Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to inform you that on **Friday 26th June 2026**, Year 2 will be going on a day trip to **Scarborough** as part of their Geography learning on coastal features. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to carry out fieldwork along Scarborough Promenade (South Bay), explore the beach as well as enjoy a local ice-cream.

Children will arrive in school promptly at 8:40am, from their usual class entrance. We will aim to depart school at 9:00am, and return by 4:30pm. If our return time changes, we will be sure to notify you via Arbor on the day of the trip.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of £21.25 per child to fund the cost of the coach transport (£20) and an ice-cream (£1.25). The trip is available to view in Arbor and you must register your child's place and make payment by **Friday 19th June 2026**. No child will be denied the opportunity to take part in the visit in the event of parents/carers being unable to pay the contribution, however, please note that if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will have to be cancelled and all monies returned. In cases of hardship you are invited to speak in confidence to Mrs Fuller.

**What to wear and pack:**

Children will wear their summer school uniform so that they are easily identifiable, including:

- Shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings which can be rolled up when they go paddling in the water.
- Comfortable walking shoes or trainers as children will walk along the South Bay Promenade whilst undertaking fieldwork.
- A light, waterproof jacket as we will spend the day outdoors/on the beach, in all weather conditions.

Please pack with following items in a medium-sized backpack which your child can carry themselves:

- A healthy packed lunch, including snacks
- Large water bottle
- Cap/hat for shade
- Sunscreen
- Small towel to dry legs and feet
- A small bucket and spade to enjoy on the beach.

If your child is travel sick, please administer their medication before they arrive in school on the morning of the trip. For the return journey, please come to the office the day before the trip to sign the necessary forms and hand in the required dose in a clearly labelled envelope/bag. Our First Aiders will administer this before they board the coach back to school.

We require around four parent/carers to support with the trip. If you would like to volunteer, please email [admin.info@greenside-sch.org](mailto:admin.info@greenside-sch.org) Names will be drawn from a hat to ensure fairness and you will be informed by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June via email. Due to health and safety guidelines, you will be placed in a group different to your child but will have the opportunity to sit together during lunch.
