Year 1 Educational Visit to Abbey House Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that on Tuesday 13th October 2026, all Year 1 will be going on a day trip to Abbey House Museum as part of our history learning. During the day, pupils will explore the museum and participate in a workshop, where they will learn how children played in the past and will have the opportunity to handle toys from different eras. They will be encouraged to discuss materials, colour and condition to learn which toys are old and new whilst having their questions answered by the workshop leader.

We aim for the trip to be the full duration of the school day and therefore will be leaving school by 9:15am and will return by 3:00pm so that pupils can be collected as normal at the end of the school day.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£12.25** per child to fund the cost of the coach transport and workshop (the cost of admission to the museum is free for Leeds LEA schools). The trip is available to view in Arbor and you must register your child's place and make payment by **Friday 2nd October**. No child will be denied the opportunity to take part in the visit in the event of parents/carers being unable to pay the contribution, however, please note that if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will have to be cancelled and all monies returned. In cases of hardship, you are invited to speak in confidence to Mrs Fuller.

On the day, children will need a healthy snack, a packed lunch and a drink. A packed lunch can be provided by school, if your child is eligible for free school meals. Please complete the following form if you wish to order a school packed lunch for your child.

Your child will need to wear their normal school uniform and wear weather appropriate clothing (e.g. waterproof jacket, hat and scarf etc.), as children will spend some time exploring Kirkstall Abbey.
